## tıwi-teqis Old Chief Joseph

Born between 1785 and 1790, tiwi-teqis came to be the principal leader of the Wallowa Nez Perce. In 1839 he was baptized and christened "Joseph," a name he carried for the rest of his life, despite

later renouncing Christianity. He died in 1871 at the traditional summer camp near the confluence of the Wallowa and Lostine Rivers. The leadership of the band passed to humató·wyalahtáit. Young Joseph.
